TASTING NOTES

COLOUR Clear and bright, with a coppery brown color and golden nuances showing greenish reflections.

AROMA Highly characteristic and complex, revealing an austere bouquet, intensely concentrated in dried fruits, spices, and exotic woods, with balsamic notes, camphor, hints of cedar wood reminiscent of cigar boxes, and aged brandy.

MOUTH The first impression is sweet, then it becomes robust and warm. It shows exuberance and intensity, leading to a very long and fresh finish, slightly saline, with notes of dried fruits and exotic spices such as saffron and curry.
